Brief Description: Sense About Maths is an education outreach program for primary schools and industry mentors to team up and bring the fun of maths into classroom and visualising STEM careers. SAM is a 6 week program with 6 different maths themes such as sets, tessellations, tangrams providing out of box and interactive learning tools for pupils and teachers. The lessons are delivered within the school time table. The primary school can be chosen by the company in their community. At the end of 6 weeks a SAM curiosity den event is organized on site in company or at school. All part of building pipeline of STEM graduates for the future and great sense of Corporate Social Responsibility.

Who delivers the program: The program is delivered by industry STEM mentors, TY/College students over a 6 week period coordinated with principal and teacher. A complete resource program and training is provided in advance

Program Cost: There is a cost for the company who chooses to sponsor the program. This is dependent on the size of the company and the number of mentors available per school.
